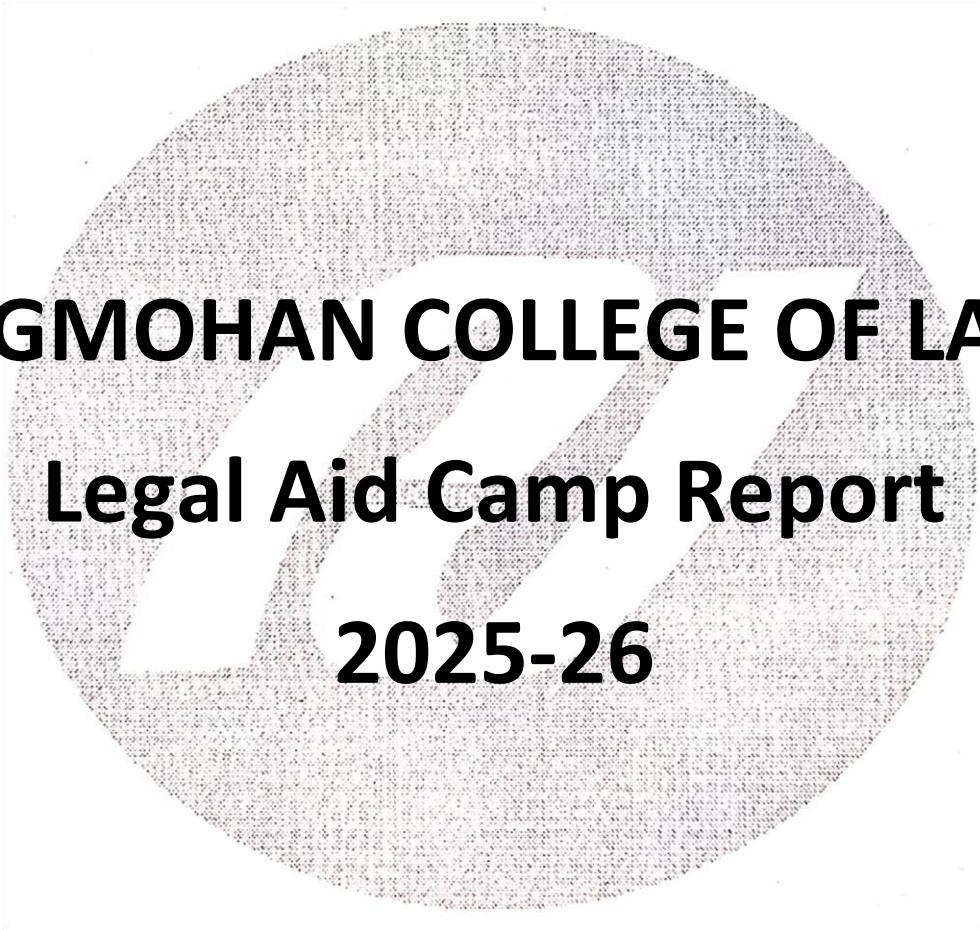

INTRODUCTION

The legal aid camp was organized by **Jagmohan College of Law** Khekra, Baghpat (Uttar Pradesh). The college is affiliated with Chaudhary Charan Singh University and approved by the Bar Council of India.

PRIMARY AIM OF THE LEGAL AID CAMP WAS TO:

- Provide **free legal advice and assistance** to residents of the rural and semi-urban areas within **Khekra tehsil**.
- Create **legal awareness** among the local population about their rights, legal procedures, and remedies available through statutory provisions.
- Facilitate **access to justice** by helping community members understand legal processes and where they can obtain further help, including government-sponsored free services such as those provided by the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA).
- Students and faculty from the college participated actively in interacting with attendees, explaining laws.



DESCRIPTION OF REPORT.

JAGMOHAN COLLEGE OF LAW had organized a Legal Aid Camp at Khekra Tehsil, Baghpat on 17-02-2026. Camp started with welcome speech by Director Mam Dr. Shalini Tyagi. After that felicitation of **Chief Guest S.D.M** Shri Nikeet Verma, **Guest of Honour Tehsildar** Ms. Virtika Sharma, **Guest of Honour President** of Khekra Tehsil Bar Shri Naveen Tyagi Advocate and Sectarary of Khekra Tehsil Bar Shri Hariom Sharma Advocate. In the beginning of the speech, the SDM emphasized that **legal aid is a fundamental right** and an essential component of social justice. He explained that many citizens, particularly those belonging to economically weaker sections, are often deprived of justice due to lack of awareness, financial constraints, and fear of legal procedures. He also appreciated the efforts of the organizers, legal professionals, and students involved in the Legal Aid Camp.
